Just two short months ago we flew multiple hauls of school supplies and reusable cloth masks in our flight training aircraft and donated them to Child Welfare Services on the islands of Molokai and Maui. Our efforts were a huge success. With the holiday season just around the corner we would like to continue sharing our aloha and extend our efforts to the island of Lanai and Kauai as well.

It is devastating to think that so many keiki could go without the Christmas spirit this year due to the circumstances of this pandemic. With the lack of resources that low-income families face on the outer islands, our community of women in aviation have found a way that we can help. With contributions from organizations and individuals like you, we can make a difference together. Let us join our efforts and bring the spirit of Aloha and Christmas into the lives of these children.

We are seeking toy donations, for children up to the age of 17, that will be given as gifts this Christmas. The Aloha Chapter 99s and Women in Aviation are both 501c (3) organizations.
